Sub: Engaging Teachers on Contract Basis, in AEC Schools, Anupuram and Kalpakkam for the Academic year 2026-2027

It is proposed to conduct the skill test for engaging teachers on contract basis against the leave / regular vacancies that may arise during the year 2026-2027 in the relevant posts.

Teaching Posts

1. Educational and other Qualifications for Post Graduate Teacher (PGT)

Essential

- (i) Master's Degree from a recognized University with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/ institution's norms) in the relevant subject.

OR

Two years' Integrated Post Graduate Course of Regional College of Education of NCERT in the relevant subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/ institution's norms).

OR

Post Graduate degree in the relevant subjects with at least 50% marks in aggregate or its equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/ institution's norms) from a recognized university and B.A.Ed. / B.Sc. Ed. from a recognized institute.

- (ii) B. Ed or equivalent degree from a recognized university. (A candidate applying for the post of PGT, Computer Science, is exempted from B. Ed qualification.)
- (iii) For the post of PGT, a candidate without B. Ed. may also apply, provided the candidate has at least 60% marks in the case of Science subjects and at least 55% marks in the case of Humanities and Commerce at the level of Post-graduation.
- (iv) If appointed on contract basis, candidates should also be ready to take teaching classes online.
Desirable: (a) Working Knowledge of Computer.
(b) Proficiency in teaching in English medium.

2. Educational and other Qualifications for Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT)

Essential

Three years' Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage, in accordance with the method of conversion of the corresponding University/Institution) in the subjects concerned / combination of subjects.

OR

Four years' integrated degree course of Regional College of Education of NCERT with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage, in accordance with the method of conversion of the corresponding University/ Institution) in the subjects concerned / combination of subjects.

1	TGT (English)	English as a subject in all the three years of graduation, B.Ed & having qualified in Paper II of CTET
2	TGT (Social Science)	Graduation with any two of the following subjects in the manner described below: History, Geography, Economics and Pol. Science, of which one of the subjects must be either History or Geography, B.Ed & having qualified in Paper II of CTET
3	TGT (Hindi/Sanskrit)	Hindi or Sanskrit as an elective subject, along with B.Ed.or equivalent, with Hindi / Sanskrit as a teaching subject & having qualified in Paper II of CTET
4	TGT (Tamil)	Tamil as an Elective Subject in graduation in all the three years & pass in B.Ed., with Tamil as teaching subject. Qualification in Paper II of CTET.
5	TGT (Mathematics/Physics)	Mathematics and Physics as subjects in graduation & B.Ed. & having qualified in Paper II of CTET A candidate who has graduated in Maths should have Maths as a subject in all three years and Physics as a subject for at least one year. A candidate who has graduated in Physics should have Physics as a subject in all three years and Maths as a subject for at least one year.
6	TGT (Biology/Chemistry)	Chemistry, Botany/Zoology as subjects in graduation, B.Ed & having qualified in Paper II of CTET A candidate who has graduated in Chemistry should have Chemistry as a subject in all three years and either Botany or Zoology as a subject for at least one year. A candidate who has graduated in Botany/Zoology should have Botany/Zoology as a subject in all three years and Chemistry as a subject for at least one year.
7	TGT (Computer Science)	Essential: B.Sc. (Computer Science) / B.Sc. (IT) / BCA or Equivalent from a recognized University with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA OR B. E or B.Tech (Computer Science / IT /Computer Engineering) from a recognized University or equivalent Degree with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA OR 'A' Level from 'DOEACC'. Ministry of Information and Communication Technology, with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA and passed graduation in any subject from a recognized University.

8	TGT (Art)	Essential: 5 years recognised Diploma in Drawing and Painting/ Sculpture/ Graphic Art or equivalent recognised degree with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/ Institution's norms). Note: Equivalent degree will be Bachelors in Fine Arts after Class XII.
9	TGT (PET – Male & Female)	Essential: Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education from a recognized University or equivalent with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University / Institution's norms)
10	TGT (SPECIAL EDUCATOR)	Essential: i) Bachelor's Degree in any subject from a recognized university. ii) B. Ed. (Special Education) with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA from a recognized university. OR B. Ed. in any subject other than Special Education and two years' Diploma in Special Education from a recognized University with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA OR B. Ed. in any subject other than Special Education and Post-Graduate Professional Diploma in Special Education from a recognized University with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA. Desirable: Those having the qualifications of Special B. Ed. (Learning Disability) and with adequate experience to handle differently-abled children
11	TGT(Counsellor)	Essential: a) B.A/B.Sc (Psychology) with certificate of diploma in counselling. b) Desirable: 1.1. Minimum of one year's experience in providing career /educational counselling to students in school. 1.2. Working knowledge and experience in placement bureaus. 1.3. Registration with Rehabilitation Council of India as vocational counsellor. 1.4. CTET is not required for TGT Counsellor.

Note:

The candidates with professional qualifications of Special B.Ed. or D.Ed. or Special D.Ed. are not eligible to apply for these posts.

- (i) If appointed on contractual basis, candidates should also be ready to take teaching classes online.
- (ii) The candidate should possess the professional qualifications of B.Ed. as on the last date of submission of the application.
- (iii) For the post of TGT, a candidate without B.Ed., but having at least 60% marks in the case of science subjects or at least 55% marks in the case of Humanities in Graduation can also apply.
- (iv) **Even though CTET is an essential qualification for some subjects of the TGT cadre, candidates without CTET qualification may also apply for those subjects.**

Desirable:

- (i) Proficiency in teaching in English Medium (except for TGT (Hindi/Sanskrit) and TGT (Tamil))
- (ii) Working knowledge of Computers

3. Educational and other qualifications for Primary Teacher (PRT) / Balvatika Teacher

1	PRT	Essential: i) Pass in Senior Secondary/ Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination or Intermediate or its equivalent with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA with English as a subject at the Plus-2 level. ii) Two years' Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed)/ Four years' Bachelor's degree in Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.) / Two years' Diploma in Education (D.Ed.) from a recognized institution. iii) Qualified in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (Paper-I) conducted by CBSE, in accordance with the guidelines framed by NCTE for this purpose. (Category 1 pertains to a candidate possessing all three essential qualifications.)
2	PRT (TAMIL)	Essential: i) Pass in Senior Secondary/ Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination or Intermediate or its equivalent with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA with Tamil as a subject at the Plus-2 level. ii) Two years' Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed)/ Four years' Bachelor's degree in Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.) / Two years' Diploma in Education (D.Ed.) from a recognized Institution. iii) Qualified in the Teacher Eligibility Test
3	PRT (Music)	Essential: Bachelor's Degree in Music from a recognized University/institute with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded or equivalent CGPA <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> Pass in Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination or Intermediate (10+2) and diploma of minimum 2 years in Music from a Govt. recognized University/Institute with a minimum of 50% marks by which diploma is awarded in aggregate or equivalent CGPA. This diploma shall be completed at least 2 years after passing Senior Secondary/Higher Secondary or Intermediate.
4	Balvatika Teacher	Qualification for Balvatika Teacher shall be as prescribed by NCTE. i) Senior Secondary class (Class XII or its equivalent) from a recognized Board with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA, with English as a subject at the Plus-2 level. ii) Diploma in Nursery Teacher Education /Pre-School Education/Early Childhood Education Programme (D. E. C. Ed.) of duration of not less than two years, or B.Ed. (Nursery) from National Council for Teacher Education, i.e., NCTE-recognized institution.

Note for PRT^s (Sl. No.1. given above):

- The candidate should possess the professional qualification of D.Ed./ D.El.Ed./B.El.Ed. as on the last date of submission of the application.
 - Even though CTET is an essential qualification for some subjects of the PRT cadre, candidates without CTET qualification may also apply for those subjects. (Category 2, pertains to a candidate possessing the essential qualifications of HSc with 50% + D.El.Ed, but lacks CTET qualification.)
 - For the post of PRT, a candidate who is at least a graduate may also apply, even in the absence of D.Ed./ D.El.Ed./B.El.Ed and CTET). (Category 3)
The panels for the three categories of PRT^s will be operated sequentially in the order of merit.
 - If appointed on contractual basis, candidates should be ready to teach online, if required.
- Desirable:** (a) Working knowledge of Computer
(b) Proficiency in teaching in English Medium

MODE OF SELECTION

Candidates will be short-listed for the Skill Test after successful verification of their documents.
(No written test will be conducted for any post of any cadre.)

The selection of Contract Teachers for empanelment from the short-listed candidates will be based on their performance in the Skill Test and Practical Classroom Observation / Demo Teaching Class.

Selected candidates will be empanelled, subject to the requirement and availability of temporary vacancies arising in the AEC Schools of Anupuram and Kalpakkam.

Panels will be formed separately on the basis of full requisite qualifications and relaxed qualifications. The panels will be operated sequentially, strictly as per AEES guidelines.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1 The date, time, and venue of the Skill Test for different subjects and cadres will be intimated in due course of time through the school notice boards of AECS, Anupuram and those of AECS-1 & AECS-2, Kalpakkam.

2 Cadre-wise details will also be displayed on the respective school websites according to the details given below: Collection and submission of application forms (Cadre-wise):

PRTs:

Application forms can be collected from the office of AECS, Anupuram and **must be submitted ONLY at the office of AECS Anupuram.**

TGTs:

Application forms can be collected from the office of AECS-1, Kalpakkam and **must be submitted ONLY at the office of AECS-1, Kalpakkam.**

PGTs:

Application forms can be collected from the office of AECS-2, Kalpakkam and **must be submitted ONLY at the office of AECS-2, Kalpakkam.**

Application forms may also be downloaded from the respective school websites.

3 Candidates must submit the application form providing details of age, qualifications, experience, and address for correspondence, along with contact number, e-mail ID and one passport-size photograph. **Self-attested photocopies of mark sheets and certificates must be enclosed with the application.**

4 The filled-in application forms along with all required documents must be submitted **STRICTLY according to the details given below:**

- For PRT cadre, submit the filled-in application & documents at AECS Anupuram.
- For TGT cadre, submit the filled-in application & documents at AECS 1, Kalpakkam.
- For PGT cadre, submit the filled-in application & documents at AECS 2, Kalpakkam.

5 The last date for submission of application forms (with documents): 23.02.2026 (Monday)

Applications must be submitted on or before 23.02.2026 during office hours.

6 Date of display of the Skill Test schedule for all posts: 03.03.2026 (Tuesday)

The schedule of the skill test will be displayed on the respective school websites and on the notice boards of AEC Schools at Anupuram and Kalpakkam.

Candidates are advised to visit the relevant school websites regularly for updates regarding the Skill Test schedule.

7 Candidates applying for more than one post must submit separate application forms for each post.


8 No TA/DA is admissible for attending the Skill Test.
